

Family Together Time

Community Hospital of San Bernardino understands how important it is for your new baby's brothers and sisters to meet their new sibling. To help you do this safely, we have established the following guidelines:

1. Siblings must be free from cold or flu symptoms, including cough, runny nose, sore throat, diarrhea, rash and/or fever.
2. Siblings must be checked in at the front desk
3. Children can not be left without adult supervision anywhere in the hospital at any time.
4. Siblings will wear pink wristbands.
5. For your protection, we ask that siblings wash their hands prior to meeting their new brother or sister. Sometimes, we may ask that you follow additional instructions to help prevent infection.
6. Siblings will remain in the mother's room.
7. Siblings will be reminded to use their quiet voices while visiting.

Sibling visitation hours: 4 pm to 6 pm

Visitors are expected to be considerate of all patients and staff. Medical or nursing staff may ask visitors to leave if they feel it is necessary for the care of the mother and new baby, or if guest behavior is disruptive or non-compliant with hospital policies.
